The annual AMA (WA) Junior Doctor of the Year (Dr Camille Michener Legacy Award) was inaugurated in 2010 to recognise the exceptional contribution of Dr Camille Michener to the Medical Profession, her colleagues and the patients she felt privileged to serve. A \$3,000 grant will be awarded annually to the winner of this prestigious Award.



About the Award

This annual Award has been established by Helen and Norm Michener, with the assistance and support of the AMA (WA), to honour the life and achievements of their beloved daughter, Dr Camille Michener, who tragically died in a car accident on 24 July 2009.

The Award recognises the significant and outstanding contribution of our Doctors in Training to the Medical Profession and the Community in areas such as teaching and education; leadership and advocacy; doctors' wellbeing and community service. These were all activities and values significant to Camille. The Award establishes a fitting legacy to all that Camille achieved in her short time with us and will ensure that we celebrate the ongoing contributions that our Doctors in Training make amongst their colleagues, the profession and in and for the Community.

Eligibility and Criteria

The Award recognises a Doctor in Training, i.e. Intern through to Senior Registrar, who has been outstanding in areas such as:

**Teaching and Education;
Leadership and Advocacy;
Doctors' Wellbeing; and
Community Service**

The requirement is that the nominee will have made a significant contribution to the Medical Profession and the Community beyond that expected of Doctors in Training in their normal working roles.

Conditions of Entry

- Nominations are to be on an official form. This includes the online form available at camille.amawa.com.au or the form within this brochure.
- The proposer must sign the nomination form but does not need to obtain the authorisation of the nominee to submit an entry.
- The nominee must be a Doctor in Training (i.e. Intern through to Senior Registrar).
- **Finalists must be a member of the AMA (WA).**
- The information provided to support the nomination can be drawn from current and previous years although more recent activities may be given greater weight in the assessment phase. Activities undertaken as a Medical Student can be included as part of the nomination.

- All nomination information and material remains the property of the AMA (WA) Junior Doctor of the Year Award Panel.
- All nomination information and material can be utilised by the AMA (WA) to publicly recognise the award recipient and award finalists and in promoting the achievements of Doctors in Training in WA. Information about the award finalists and winner may be published in the AMA (WA) monthly journal *Medicus* and/or *Med e-link*.
- The decision of the Selection Panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Self-nomination is permissible.
- Nominations must be received by 4.30pm on Monday 15 April 2019.

Selection Procedure

The Selection Panel comprises Senior Practitioner and Doctors in Training representatives, including the current President of the AMA (WA) and two representatives of the AMA (WA) Council together with the current Chair/Co-Chair of the Doctors in Training Committee plus either one or two representatives from the Doctors in Training Committee such that there are three representatives in total from the Doctors in Training Committee.

The Selection Panel will meet to determine and select the finalists and the Award recipient based on the information contained in the nomination submission. Further information regarding the submission may be sought to assist in clarifying any aspect of the nomination.

A representative from the AMA (WA) will notify each nominee of their nomination.

Call for nominations and entries.

Monday 15 April 2019

Entries close at 4.30pm.

May 2019

Panel identifies finalists and winner.

Nominees will be notified if they are shortlisted as a finalist.

Saturday 22 June 2019

Presentation of Award at the AMA (WA) Awards and Charity Dinner.

- b. Provide a statement as to how the nominee has provided outstanding service/performance within the Medical Profession and the Community. Demonstration can be in areas such as:
 - Teaching and Education
 - Leadership and Advocacy
 - Doctors' Wellbeing
 - Community Service
(Max 1,500 words)
- c. If nominating yourself, describe the intended use of the \$3000 prize money if successful. (The expectation of the Award Selection Panel is that the prize money will be used for ongoing professional development). (Max 200 words).
Note: If you are nominating another person, the AMA (WA) will contact your nominee for this information.

Supporting Documentation

- d. To support the entry, it is allowable for the following information to be attached:
 - Testimonials/References
 - Newspaper/Media Clippings
 - Promotional material such as flyers, brochures, manuals that may have been developed
